Making Denmark Great Again!

The Seminar will be held in the Yorkshire Room at the Cambridge Hotel & Conference Centre as per the schedule listed below.

Monday afternoon starts with introductions in the Yorkshire classroom at 4:00 pm, followed by a speaker and Welcome Dinner at 6:00 pm. And then an evening presentation on Danish food culture.

Tuesday begins with a hot breakfast in the main lobby restaurant, opening at 6:30 AM. The program starts at 9:00 AM in the Yorkshire Room with Morgensang, followed by a report from Danish Parliamentarian Heidi Bank.

After lunch, enjoy a presentation on the Danish design tradition, exploring its history and guiding principles. In the afternoon, there will be a screening of the Oscar-nominated 2024 film, *The Girl with the Needle*. Our 3-Course Plated Dinner will be followed by a sing-along with songs from Højskolesangbogen.

Wednesday after breakfast, join us in the Yorkshire Room for Morgensang followed by a presentation on how Danish movie production became world-famous. After lunch, enjoy free time to relax or explore for the rest of the day.

Thursday after breakfast, join us in the Yorkshire Room for Morgensang, followed by a presentation from Pastor Simon Kangas on how to defend Danish culture. Later, Defence Attaché Kasper Ladegaard will share insights on protecting Denmark. The afternoon includes a hands-on workshop, and the day concludes with dinner, followed by a Goodbye Party featuring entertainment and a lottery.

Friday at 8:30am, meet for a Goodbye Breakfast in the main lobby restaurant.

Who are the teachers?

Headmaster: Pastor Kirstine Rasmussen has served as pastor of the Danish Lutheran Church of Toronto since October 2023. Before moving to Canada, she was a pastor at Søndermarkskirken in Viborg and has also served at the Danish Church in Australia, gaining international experience in ministry and church life. She holds degrees in theology from both Aarhus University and the University of Copenhagen. Her academic interests focus especially on N. F. S. Grundtvig, with particular attention to his hymn writing and its lasting significance for faith and worship.

Speaker: Heidi Farsøe Bank is a member of the Danish Parliament (*Folketinget*) representing the liberal party Venstre. She has served multiple terms as a parliamentary representative for the East Jutland constituency. She has a broad and diverse educational background. Within Parliament, she has held several leadership and spokesperson roles, including: Housing spokesperson (*boligordfører*), Spokesperson for education and research, Spokesperson on citizenship and immigration issues (*indfødsretsordfører*), Internal affairs spokesperson (*indenrigsordfører*), Chairing the Gender Equality Committee (2019–2022), Vice Chair of the Interior and Housing Committee (2021–2022).

Speaker Commander Kasper Flinker Ladegaard is the Danish Defence Attaché to Canada. He has worked intensely on Arctic and High North security and defence policy. Policy advisor for commander Joint Arctic Command. Transatlantic, Faroese and Greenlandic relations.

Speaker Oscar Bang Hansen is studying Media and Film at Copenhagen University.

Speaker Simon Kangas Larsen, Former Pastor at the Danish Church in Toronto.
